Contract Choral Director

The Contract Choral Director position is 25% FTE with an hourly salary of \$30.

The Contract Choral Director is responsible for coordinating and administering an effective, vibrant, inspirational, well-rounded singing ministry and providing leadership to professionals and volunteers involved in it.

Reports to: Executive Minister of Religious Education

Responsibilities (7.5 hours/week):

- Collaborates with the Church's Minister, Worship Leaders, Worship Associates, or Guest Speakers in the creation of Worship Services twice monthly.
- Selects music for a given weekly service in consultation with the Minister, Worship Leader, or Guest Speaker.
- Engages with other musicians.
- Coordinate rehearsals with the choir and the church's house band
- Maintains a network of music colleagues from UU churches and the community at large for the purposes of professional enrichment and identifying candidates for performance with the choir.

Administrative Duties (2.5 hours/month):

- Consults with Minister on music budget.
- Maintains music library.
- Attends monthly meetings of the Worship Team.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Preferably a Baccalaureate Degree in music, or equivalent liturgical music experience, or equivalent professional secular music experience
- Experience in musical performance and leading a choral program
- Vocal training or successful vocal performance experience
- Appreciation and knowledge of sacred music, particularly from the Unitarian Universalist tradition
- Openness to Unitarian Universalism and its values
